## Theresa Anderson to Minister to Women, Serve as Support Worker

NORCROSS, Ga. – The Mission Society, which sends Christian missionaries worldwide on ministry assignments, has consecrated Theresa Anderson of Phenix City, Ala., as a missionary to Peru.

The Most Reverend Dr. Robert Kwasi Aboagye-Mensah, past presiding bishop of The Methodist Church - Ghana and a member of The Mission Society's board of directors, spoke during the Nov. 1 service where Anderson was consecrated.

Anderson plans to serve as a support to missionaries in Huancayo, Peru, and develop strong relationships with women, young and old, who struggle with lost hopes and dreams. Her future hope is to develop a home that will provide care for abandoned children and the elderly.

"Theresa will be providing critical assistance to The Mission Society team in Huancayo and compassion to women who need to know about God's deep, abiding love for them," said Dick McClain, president and CEO of The Mission Society. "We are honored to deploy her as a career missionary."
