## Global Outreach Weekend Focuses on Local Church's Role in World Missions

LIBERTY, N.Y. — The Mission Society, which sends Christian missionaries worldwide on ministry assignments, will present a Global Outreach Weekend to the members of Liberty Free Methodist Church, beginning at 7 p.m. Dec. 2, and continuing through noon Dec. 4.

"Jesus' last message to his disciples was that they be his witnesses to the ends of the earth," said Roger Wright, Midwest regional director for church ministry of The Mission Society. "To achieve this mandate, Jesus followers must extend the love of Christ into their neighborhoods as well as abroad. Not only is this mobilization essential for the advancement of the gospel, but also it's vital to the spiritual well-being of the local church."

Wright, a missions mobilizer, will conduct the Global Outreach Weekend. Wright is passionate about training church pastors and leaders to more effectively fulfill the Great Commission. He teaches and mentors them to broaden their vision to reach individuals with the love of Christ.

The <u>Global Outreach Weekend</u> is designed to help Christians understand the biblical basis of worldwide missions and challenge them to become more involved in local and international outreach. It includes a six-hour seminar and ministry to the entire congregation through Sunday worship and adult Sunday school classes.
