Healing only Jesus can provide

Born during Liberia's 14-year civil war and orphaned after the Ebola crisis, Uriah felt hopeless . . . until he met Randy and Pati Walchle, cross-cultural workers who were serving in Liberia.

Uriah was the Walchles' night watchman. As Randy and Pati got to know him, Uriah shared about the trauma of his childhood.

God connecting Uriah to the Walchles was no accident. The couple's ministry in Liberia included leading trauma healing workshops, which Uriah began to attend.

"The trauma healing program is an experience in taking one's pain to the cross," said Randy. "Jesus is the path by which we are rescued, restored, healed, made whole, and through Him we can build a new life."

Recently, Uriah completed the facilitator training courses. He will soon be leading the trauma healing courses himself, offering others the healing he has experienced.



Recycled cans provide clean water

Mike and Anne Kelley of Madison, Alabama, didn't set out to start a movement, they just wanted to provide clean water for people.

They came up with a simple idea: to recycle aluminum cans and save for a well in Africa.

Members of their church, Asbury United Methodist Church, heard about the can collection and wanted to get involved. As word spread, cans began coming from around the community.

After one year, Mike and Anne had raised \$11,500, enough to drill three wells.

The couple partnered with TMS Global cross-cultural worker, Mary Kay Jackson, a civil engineer working to bring water and sanitation to remote villages in Ghana, West Africa.

Today, nine years later, Mike and Anne have helped raise \$37,500 for clean water in Ghana. What started with one couple grew into a ministry that impacted thousands of people in Ghana. Mary Kay, and short-term teams from the church, connected the Living Water Jesus offers with people's need and thirst for clean water.
