

Ideas for Outreach Service Day

- Call your local mission partners to determine how you can help support them through the day's events.
- Consider any upcoming short-term mission trips. Find out if the team has any needs for that trip. For
 example, they may need help prepping Vacation Bible School materials. Ask the mission partners if
 there are any activities that the congregation could do over the course of the weekend to help their
 ministries.
- Consider writing cards and letters of encouragement to each of your mission partners and partner organizations.
- Some churches coordinate church-wide events such as packing meals. There are outside organizations that will help you plan all the details of this event.
- If your church is used for a mission outreach such as a food pantry, AA meeting group, tutoring center, etc., you could clean or do projects to spruce up the area as a mission effort.
- Make sure that your requests for the day are not financial, since a financial request will come through Faith Promise later in the week.
- Events can be onsite or offsite to visit mission partners. If it is offsite, make sure you have transportation needs met in advance. Also, you will need to secure permission forms for youth or children traveling without parents.
