## **The Mission Society helps equip Smyrna church for strategic outreach**

### ***Interactive workshop: Making a difference in and beyond our community***

SMYRNA, Ga.—Members of Smyrna First United Methodist Church will gain a greater understanding of global outreach when The Mission Society, which sends Christian missionaries worldwide on ministry assignments, presents a Global Outreach Weekend March 9-11.

"God has chosen the local church as His instrument to spread the gospel to the ends of the earth," said Stan Self, senior director of church ministry for The Mission Society. "The challenge is encouraging Christians to leave the four walls of the church to reach their neighborhoods and world. This is essential both to advance the gospel and maintain the spiritual health of the local church."

Self, who directs mobilization efforts that strategically engage local churches in worldwide evangelism, will lead the weekend's events.

The Global Outreach Weekend, which begins at 7 p.m. Friday, March 9, is designed to help Christians understand the biblical basis of worldwide missions and challenge them to become more involved in local and international outreach. Workshops will continue at 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m. March 10. The weekend will conclude with three missions-focused worship services at 8:45 a.m., 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. March 11.

The event is open to area churches.
