Weekend Brings Personal Challenge for Missions Involvement

GULF BREEZE, Fla. – The Mission Society, which sends Christian missionaries worldwide on ministry assignments, will present a Global Outreach Weekend Aug. 17-19 at St. Paul United Methodist Church.

The Global Outreach Weekend is designed to bring a greater awareness of the biblical basis of missions, the needs that exist around the world and at home, and the challenge to become involved.

“People are waiting to hear the message of salvation and see Christ in us,” said Stan Self, senior director of church ministry of The Mission Society. “As Christians, we must equip ourselves with knowledge and tools that will better enable us to be His witnesses.”

The weekend will include a Global Outreach Workshop starting Friday, Aug. 17, at 7 p.m. and concluding Saturday, Aug. 18, at 1:00 p.m. In addition to the workshop, on Sunday morning, Aug. 19, ministry will be provided to the entire congregation in worship and Sunday school classes or small groups.
