## Because of you, students in Thailand are following Jesus

Chris and Dora Barbee live and work at a welfare school in Roi Et, Thailand. Jiin\* has been involved in the Barbees' ministry for years. She made the decision to follow Jesus and has been growing in her faith. Over time, Jiin developed into a student leader and started discipling other Thai students in their relationship with Jesus.

### Jiin's struggle

During a student retreat, Jiin opened up to Chris and Dora about the struggles she was experiencing.

She wept and said, "It is all so hard. I love Jesus. He is so good to me, and I love growing with Him, but my family makes it so hard."

Jiin's family are strict Buddhists and believe that their daughter's life needs to be focused on the rituals of the Buddhist religion. Jiin knows that following Jesus is about a relationship with Him, and many of the things she is being asked to do by her parents seem to be at odds with her blossoming faith in Jesus. **Jiin knows that she is the greatest**

During the retreat, Jiin prayed for understanding. Chris and Dora taught about Jesus and how He provided an example as to how we should live. One night, the Barbees held a foot-washing ceremony with their students.

The Thai culture views feet as the dirtiest part of the body, unfit to be touched by anyone. As Chris and Dora taught about Jesus washing people's feet, and as they washed their students' feet, understanding of His humble nature swept over the kids.

Jiin said, **"Thank you for reminding me about how amazing Jesus is! It makes all the difficult situations worth it!"**

"We want to invest in the lives of our students and help them find opportunities to be a blessing to their families and their community," said Chris. "Jiin

is learning to follow Jesus respectfully inside her Buddhist culture. These students are the greatest hope for their families to ever encounter the love of Jesus."

## Your support is spreading the gospel in Malawi

Moses\* had always been looked down upon by his neighbors in Malawi. He is a subsistence farmer who struggles to grow enough maize to feed his family. That changed when he encountered Foundations for Farming.

Dean and Stefanie Babcock teach Foundations for Farming principles, which are proven techniques that help local farmers grow more and healthier crops.

Dean recently attended a Foundations for Farming conference in Malawi. At the event, 70 people gathered to share ideas and stories of the impact the program has had on their lives.

### Moses' success

Moses attended the conference and told the other farmers how he had struggled with his crops and how his neighbors disrespected him. He began to use Foundations for Farming principles, and everything changed. Dean said, "Moses harvested 20 bags of maize, then 33 bags."

Amazed by Moses' success, three of his neighbors then began to use the same principles, then 10, then even more. Dean said, "In addition to helping people have adequate food, there are opportunities to walk alongside these farmers, pray with them, and share what the Bible has to say about their situations."

## Muslim chiefs come to faith in Jesus

At the same conference, Dean heard other encouraging testimonies of transformation. “In a mostly Muslim area of the country, loving people through farming has broken through opposition and opened many doors,” said Dean. “Four Muslim chiefs have been baptized in Christ. **One confessed that he used to send curses on people before he knew Jesus. Now he is teaching his neighbors about better farming methods and sharing with them about new life in Christ.**”

In a country that suffers from droughts, flooding, and constant food security issues, the Babcocks are meeting a felt need while sharing the gospel. Dean leads a Bible study for anyone who is interested in learning more about following Jesus, preaches in local churches, and encourages pastors. Dean and Stefanie share their faith with Malawians (many of whom are Muslim), both in the course of life and through their teaching.
